Works

This website highlights a selection of the works from the portfolio of sculptor Andy Scott. Since graduation from Glasgow School of Art in 1987 Andy has worked across a diverse range of artistic & creative projects. Public sculpture has been at the forefront of his activities, with dozens of commissions completed for a wide client base including corporate and civic organisations, public housing associations, sports and leisure groups and private clients.

Andy is a figurative sculptor and works in steel and bronze. He combines traditional figurative symbolism and artforms with contemporary fabrication techniques to create iconic sculptures for the public realm. His portfolio and studio practice concentrates on handskills, draughtsmanship and manual dexterity.



Many of Andy's projects also incorporate educational aspects, especially the numerous commissions undertaken for Housing Associations and residential developments. In these instances Andy works with specifically appointed arts teachers to engage with community groups and schools, which helps demystify the role of the artist, explain the artwork and in some instances even incorporate the creative input of those communities.

Over the past few years Andy's practice has extended to Australia where he established a workshop in S.E. Queensland. He has established a presence in the field of public sculpture there which compliments his ongoing prodigious output of artworks from his base in his native city of Glasgow, Scotland.
